COVID-19 Safety Precautions

South Carolina is now categorized as Code Red and Code Orange which relates to the transmission rate of Covid-19. We ask that you please cooperate with us as we continue to monitor/adjust/adapt to the New Normal. As always, your safety has been and continues to be our # 1 Priority.

Please expect Thermal Checks upon entry.

Thermal checks of 100.0 degrees or higher or visible signs of Covid 19 are not permitted inside the facility. Individuals will be asked to leave the premises immediately to protect the health and safety of others.

Face Mask Mandate for Richland County

UPDATE, MARCH 2: At its meeting March 1, Richland County Council extended an [emergency ordinance](#) requiring face coverings to be worn by people 11 years and older inside most commercial establishments in unincorporated areas of the County. **The ordinance is set to expire May 1.** Council first adopted this emergency ordinance in September 2021 following a surge in the coronavirus delta variant. On Jan. 4, 2022, the ordinance was extended.

Please always wear your mask properly while on the premises. Continued monitoring in progress for compliance.

Please refrain from sharing materials/ touching/hugging/kissing while on the premises.

Feel free to move about the facility to utilize the restrooms.

Please utilize the outer and inner aisles and avoid crossing over others.

Please ensure safe distances between yourself and others by always staying 3 feet apart. This excludes families and individuals of the same household.

Covid 19 Symptoms

Please stay home if you are experiencing any from the list below.

COVID-19 affects different people in different ways. Infected people have had a wide range of symptoms reported – from mild symptoms to severe illness.

Symptoms may appear 2-14 days after exposure to the virus. People with these symptoms may have COVID-19:

Fever or chills

Cough

Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing

Fatigue

Muscle or body aches

Headache

New loss of taste or smell

Sore throat

Congestion or runny nose

Nausea or vomiting

Diarrhea

Look for emergency warning signs for COVID-19. If someone is showing any of these signs, seek emergency medical care immediately:

Trouble breathing

Persistent pain or pressure in the chest

New confusion

Inability to wake or stay awake

Pale, gray, or blue-colored skin, lips, or nail beds, depending on skin tone

Call your medical provider for any other symptoms that are severe or concerning to you.
