

Ridgewood Missionary Baptist Church Scholarship

Purpose

The purpose of the Ridgewood Missionary Baptist Church Scholarship is to acknowledge the efforts of the member high school graduate who has made outstanding contributions to the church, school and community; and to inspire the member graduate (including GED recipients) of the church to strive for high academic standing. All high school graduates will be recognized in church on the third Sunday in June.

Criteria

To be considered for the Ridgewood Missionary Baptist Church Scholarship, the applicant must meet the following criteria:

- An active participant in Youth activities of the church.
- Applicant must have a “C” or 2.0 or higher-grade point average.
- Applicant must be matriculating at a college, university, or other accredited institution of higher learning. Applicants must be accepted at the institution before a scholarship award can be sent. The scholarship award check will be made payable to the institution and mailed directly to the financial aid office.
- Only complete applications with an official high school transcript submitted on or before the deadline will be considered. A checklist is provided for your convenience.
- All applicants will be interviewed by a panel from the Scholarship Committee.

Special consideration may be given to applicants who are experiencing financial hardships.
